PATH Act Tax Related Documentation

According to the IRS website, The Protecting Americans from Tax Hikes Act of 2015 (the PATH Act), was enacted on December 18, 2015 (<u>IRS.gov</u>). The PATH Act contains several changes to the tax law that affect individuals, families, businesses and help safeguard against tax fraud.

It may be possible that your tax preparer requires documentation which proves your child is enrolled in school and provides the child's address. According to the tax offices we have contacted, you may use the following documents (as long as they have the child's name and address listed) to submit to your tax preparer:

- Child's Progress Report
- Child's Report Card
- Child's Demographic Sheet
