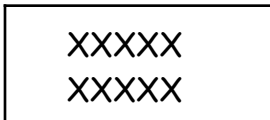

Math Focus:

During the next few weeks, our math class will continue learning about multiplication. Students will demonstrate the commutativity of multiplication and practice related facts by skip counting objects in array models.

Draw an array that shows 2 groups of 5.



Write a multiplication sentence to show the array.

$$2 \times 5 = 10$$

Now, show the commutative property.

$$5 \times 2 = 10$$

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Multiplication Facts:

Students will have a multiplication test on Friday, September 24. We will do the 3's again next week, so please help your child practice their 3's at home,

Skip Counting:

Students need to practice skip counting by 3's and 4's.

Vocabulary We will Use in Class:

Array - a set of objects in rows and columns

Equal groups - groups that have the same number of objects

Factor - a number that is multiplied by another number to find a product

Multiply - when you multiply, you combine equal groups to find how many in all

Product - the answer in a multiplication problem
