## Hartselle City Schools' COVID PROTOCOLS Parent Guide August, 2023



As Hartselle City Schools begins the 2023-2024 school year, the following guidance is offered based on current recommendations from the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

\*Please note that protocols are subject to change as conditions change\*

- Individuals who test positive for COVID should follow up with their health care provider for guidance.
- Individuals who test positive for COVID via home test are advised to follow up with their health care provider. However, those
  who choose not to follow up with a health care provider should follow ADPH/CDC guidance which states person should
  isolate for 5 days after symptom onset.
- Individuals who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 should stay home for 5 days following the onset of symptoms or the positive test result, be 24 hours without fever or fever- reducing medications before returning to school *unless otherwise* advised by his/her healthcare provider.

## **Attendance Protocols for 2023-2024**

There are no longer "COVID" codes within Powerschool. Therefore, for those who test positive for COVID will need to present a MD note or parent excuse.
