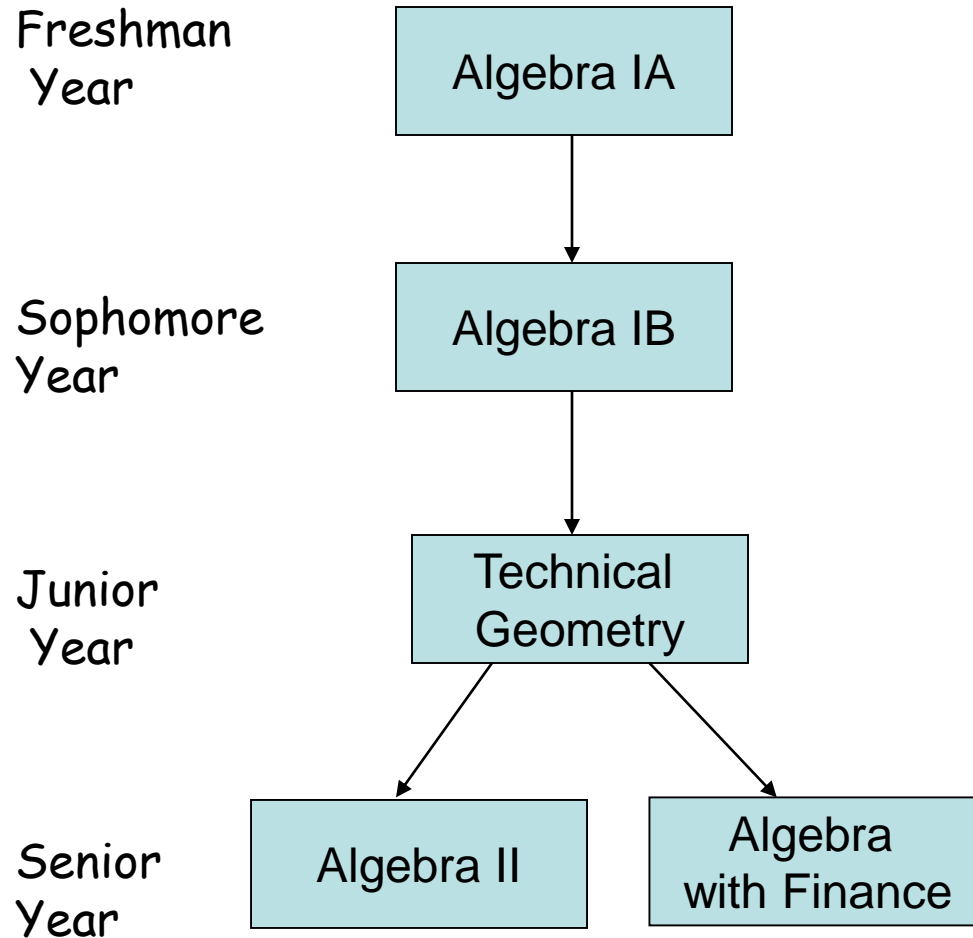

Path 1 – Standard Diploma

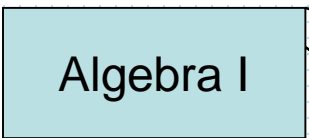

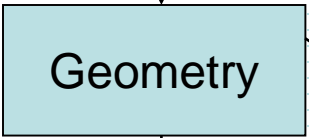

Path 2 – Standard Diploma College or Career Ready

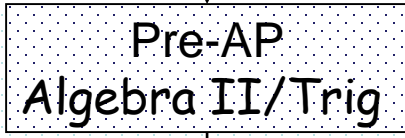
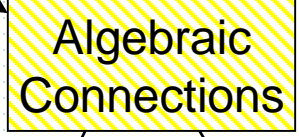
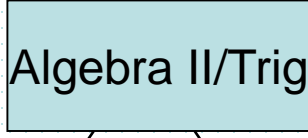

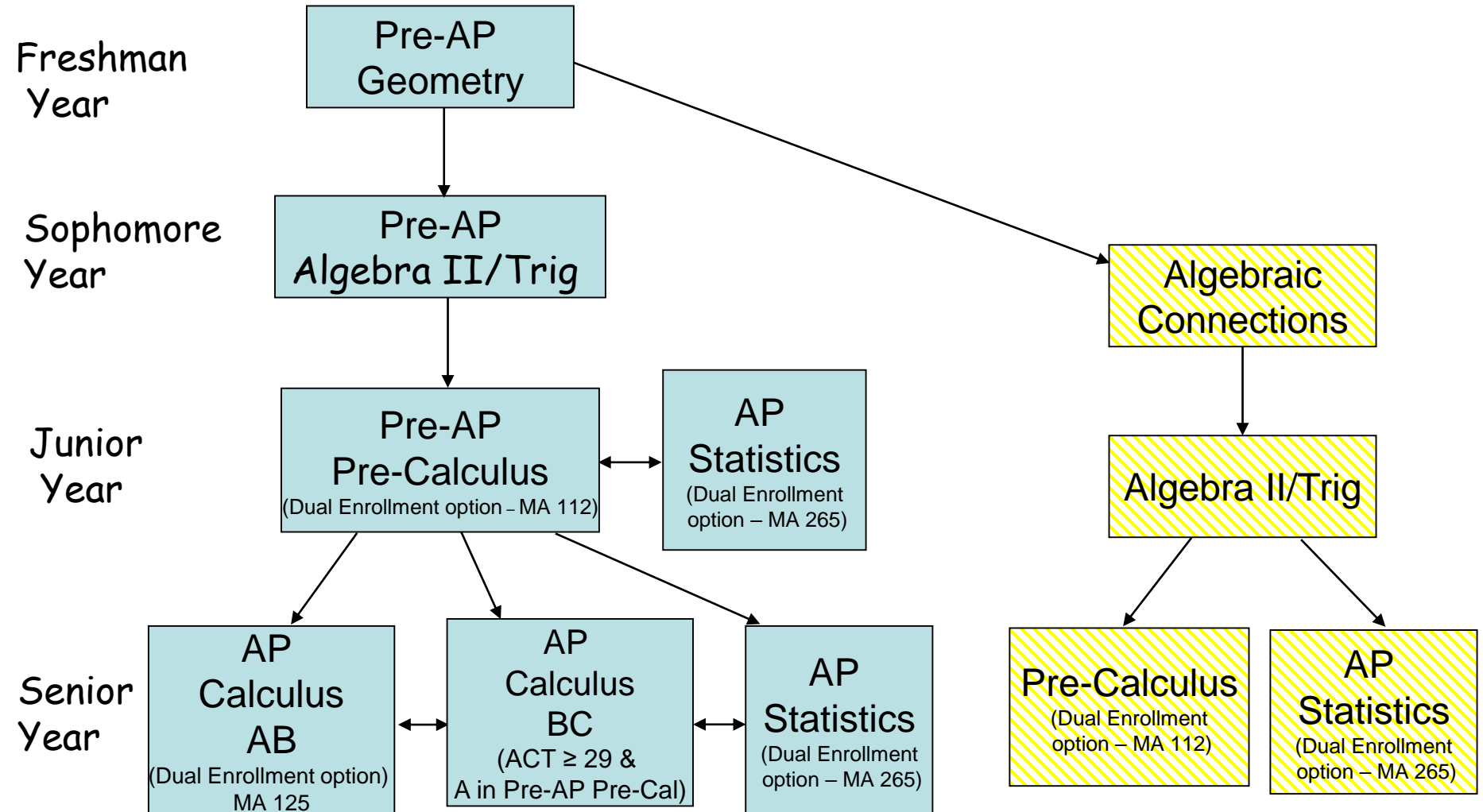


- Solid Box is the Preferred Path!
