MAKE A PLAN ON WHERE WOULD YOU LIKE TO SERVE Make a plan and ask. Let's Get Started

Making a plan means that you arrange everything before the night of

September 2nd. Wherever you choose to serve will need to make arrangements for you to arrive, as well as, gather any materials you will need during your serve time. They may be unable to provide you with what you need to complete your tasks, so this is something that you will need to communicate with them in your conversation.

HOW DO YOU ASK TO SERVE?

EXAMPLES:

If I were to call Faith House or Clothe Our Kids:

"My name is _____. I am a <u>7th/8th</u> grade student at Hartselle Jr. High. We are having a serve day on September 3. My friends and I are looking for a place to volunteer our time. We have 10 people in our group. Do you have time available on September 3rd for us to come and help? **Let them respond and go from there!**

If I were to call Hospice:

"My name is ______. I am a <u>7th/8th</u> grade student at Hartselle Jr. High. We are having a serve day on September 3. I am looking for a place to volunteer my time. Maybe you have flower beds that need to be cleaned out or another opportunity that I could help with..." Let them respond and go from there!

"Will you have materials available for me to clean out the flower beds or should I bring my own." (Items such as: rake, gloves, bucket for weeds, trash bags for leaves, etc) **Let them respond and go from there!**
